Since its inception in 1974, ATSC has helped more than 10,000 families in Orange County. Relying primarily on private contributions, ATSC is the only agency in the community offering family counseling services at no charge. Dedicated to the purpose "Arrest the Problem, Not the Child," the agency works to divert children from destructive behavior that interferes with family and social relationships, and educational success.
